## June 12, 2008 G.I. Rotary Board Meeting Minutes

In Attendance: President Hickman, President Elect Aller, Treasurer Pelteir, Secretary Klemans, Past President Krauss, Director Sims, Service Projects – International Chair Taylor, Public Relations Chair Strain, Sergeant at Arms Soedarjatno

The 5-15-08 Board meeting minutes (as distributed) were unanimously approved.

President Elect Aller stated that the Changing of the Guard would be on June 26, at the GIGCC and that members are invited to bring spouses and guests; the Madison School boat outing and luncheon will be on July 24 at the GI Yacht Club; Governor Bruce Goldsen's visit, a boat outing, will be August 28.

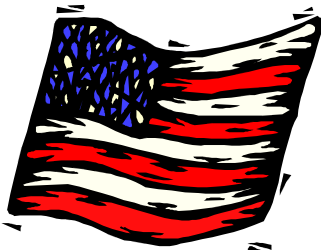
Treasurer Peltier provided a condensed verbal update (due to the power outage) of the May financial statement: ending balance = \$54,793; 6 - 12 - 08 Golf Outing netted approximately \$6,500. **Sims moved and Aller seconded that the verbal Treasurer's report be accepted – passed unanimously.**

President Hickman presented a request from Chuck Moyer for a leave of six weeks to coach his son's baseball team that plays their games on Tuesdays and Thursdays. **Sims moved and Krauss seconded that Chuck Moyer be granted a six week leave of absence to coach his son's baseball team that pays their games on Tuesdays and Thursdays – passed unanimously.**

President Hickman read an e - mail from Roberto Sanchez which encouraged the GI Rotary to immediately respond to a request from Rotary clubs near Sandi Soedajatno's home village in the Phillipines. Sandi's village was destroyed by a hurricane about three weeks ago. The village residents are in desperate need of basic essentials (water, food, clothing, cooking fuel, etc.). **Krauss moved and Klemans seconded that \$1000 be sent to the requesting Rotary Club to be used to provide basic essentials for the residents of Sandi Soedarjatno's homevillage in the Phillipines that was destroyed by a hurricane approximately three weeks ago – passed unanimously.**

Peltier moved and Aller seconded that shirts purchased by the Club for approximately \$25 be offered to the membership for \$25 – passed unanimously.
