Dear D6400 Rotarians,

Many Rotarians dream about travelling to give polio vaccine drops to a child overseas. This Rotary year your dreams can be realized. Mary Jean and I are pleased to invite you to join us and other Rotarians and guests to travel to India for National Immunization Days (NID). You will have the opportunity to join first hand in the effort to eradicate polio. We leave Detroit late afternoon of 4 February and return on the morning of 22 February 2010. Air transportation can be arranged from anywhere in the world.

We are assembling a team with three initiatives:

- First, we will help eradicate polio by participating in at least one NID.
- Second, we are taking part in a Vision Camp to bring sight to those who cannot afford eye glasses or cataract surgery.
- Third, we will enjoy touring India and seeing sights (Taj Mahal, Tiger Safari, Delhi, Mumbai and others) and visiting Rotary projects. (A detailed itinerary is on our website.)
