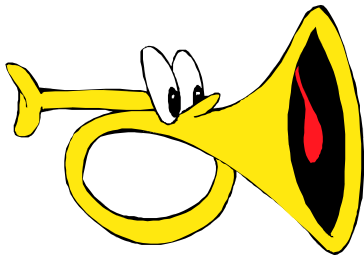

From Telegraph Road- Take Telegraph Road to Gibraltar Road. (There is a 5/3 bank on the corner of Telegraph and Gibraltar). Drive East on Gibraltar Road 2.8 miles. Turn right onto Commerce Drive. Turn left onto Maguire St.

From I-75 Freeway- Take I-75 to Exit 29B (Gibraltar Road). Drive West on Gibraltar road for less than 1/4 of a mile. Turn left onto Gateway Commerce Drive. Turn left onto One Maguire.

From I-275 Freeway- Take I-275 to Exit 8 (Will Carleton Road). Drive East on Will Carleton Road for 4.5 miles until Will Carleton ends. Turn left onto Telegraph Road. Turn right onto Gibraltar Road (there is a 5/3 bank on the corner of Telegraph and Gibraltar). Drive East on Gibraltar Road 2.8 miles. Turn right onto Commerce Drive. Turn left onto Maguire Street.
