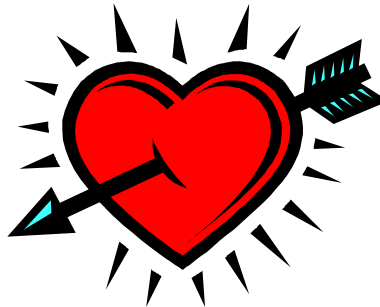

The Group Study Exchange program is a unique cultural and vocational exchange opportunity for business and professional men and women in the initial years of their careers. The program is designed to develop professional and leadership skills among young people to better prepare them to address the needs of their communities and an increasingly global workplace.

Past Group Study Exchange teams in our District 6400 have visited Chile, Germany, Belgium, Japan, South Africa, Russia, Brazil, India, Finland, Taiwan and Greece, among other places.

GSE team consists of four non-Rotarian business or professional people and a Rotarian team leader. Applicants must:

- be between the ages of 25 and 40;
- be in the early stages of their careers or professions;
- reside in or be employed in the sending Rotary district and also be citizens of the country in which they reside;
- be open-minded, tolerant, and flexible;
- be comfortable working as part of a team with a schedule that is physically and emotionally demanding.
